



The Viravento educational project was created to provide the Primary Education sector of state schools in Galicia and Castile-La Mancha with teaching resources. The children and their teachers in the areas neighbouring the wind farms of Enel Unión Fenosa Renovables are the beneficiaries of an educational project designed to reinforce their awareness of the environment and the proper interpretation of the concept of sustainability.

Viravento is a unique educational project in Europe. There is no other project in the field of renewable energy which like Viravento can take the student right through the primary education curriculum. Each year, thousands of children discover the age-old elements such as the sun, water, wind or plants through the understandable and entertaining language of Viravento. They are led along a path which guides them towards achieving understanding as individuals who know that there is a goal to achieve: sustainable development of the planet they live in.

In 2008, educational activities on renewable energies were developed in 49 schools in the regions of Galicia and Castile-La Mancha, with more than 7,000 children taking part. As well as providing various instruction and recreational materials, visits were also organised to some of the wind farms that the company has in these regions.
